

ELECTRICAL SAFETY RULES

PREVENT SHOCK, ARC FLASH AND FIRE

ISOLATE • LOCK OUT • VERIFY ZERO ENERGY

01

NO UNAUTHORIZED WORK

- Only authorized personnel may work on electrical equipment.
- Stay clear of open panels and energized work areas.

02

ISOLATE THE ENERGY

- Identify all energy sources before maintenance or repair.
- Apply all required lockout and tagout controls.

03

TEST BEFORE TOUCH

- Verify absence of voltage with a suitable test instrument.
- Check the tester before and after use.

04

DO NOT USE DAMAGED EQUIPMENT

- Inspect cables, plugs, extensions and enclosures before use.
- Remove damaged equipment from service immediately.

05

USE SUITABLE PPE AND TOOLS

- Use insulated tools suitable for the task.
- Wear arc-rated PPE where the assessment requires it.

06

KEEP THE AREA SAFE

- Keep electrical panels accessible, clean and dry.

STOP WORK IMMEDIATELY

- ✓ Conductors are exposed
- ✓ Isolation is not verified
- ✓ Equipment is damaged
- ✓ Authorized personnel are absent
